We have been a bit naughty and released two newsletters in December! We just have too much news to share 😳 Please expect one a month in 2025.

You may or may not know that Mann Cottage Surgery is part of the North Cotswolds Primary Care Network (PCN). The PCN consists of us, Whitehouse Surgery, Chipping Campden Surgery, Stow Surgery and Cotswold Medical Practice. As part of this network, we are able to book appointments with shared specialist clinics such a First Contact Physio, Primary Care Mental Health, Women's Health and Minor Surgery.

Primary Care Network – Frailty Task Force

The PCN team has been developing a team of skilled individuals to help support our frail and elderly patients in our community. In August 2021 the Community Matrons had a waiting list of 24 patients, so the primary care network team started to evaluate how they could improve access and support the community team to help more patients. A new referral pathway to the Moreton based Frailty Task force was set up and the surgeries started to refer more patients for support. This has now led to a well - managed community caseload of 190 patients as of 22/11/2024!

Weekly meetings are held between a multi-disciplinary team consisting of Care Co-ordinators, Wellbeing Coaches, Community Matrons, Clinical Pharmacists, and a Consultant Geriatrician.

This MDT approach is providing holistic care for Frail patients in our community with multiple and complex needs. We are very proud to be trail blazing with this new model as other PCNs across Gloucester are now being advised to set up similar working processes. Well done Team North Cots!

THINK Pharmacy First



Think pharmacy first Subject to age eligibility, including 1-f7 years add for earache prescription medicine. Service available at migority of pharmacies.



Did you know you can visit your local community pharmacy for help if you have certain conditions?

Condition	Age eligibility
UTI	16-64 years
Sinusitis	12 years and over
Earache	1-17 years
Sore throat	5 years and over
Shingles	18 years and over
Impetigo	1 year and over
Infected Insect Bite	1 year and over

For the 7 common conditions listed here, pharmacists will follow a robust clinical pathway which includes self-care and safety-netting advice and, only if appropriate, a supply of prescription only medicines without the need to visit a GP. If you ever need help with any of the above conditions please do consider visiting the Pharmacy FIRST. You will be advised to visit your GP if the pharmacist cannot help.

Just a reminder to THINK CARE!

Condition	The Receptionist will ask you a few questions regarding the problem you are calling about.
Assessment	The Receptionist will need your help to assess the timeframe in which you will need to be seen for a safe outcome.
Referral	The Receptionist with your help, will decide which healthcare professional you need to see.
Examination	The Receptionist will book your appointment with the most appropriate clinician for your problem.
